## KAOW Onam 2019 Program Rules

- 1. All participants must be 2019 KAW members. If you haven't taken the membership or haven't renewed it this year, you could do so at KAW website: <a href="https://kaow.org/login.aspx">https://kaow.org/login.aspx</a>
- 2. All entries will be reviewed once the registration is closed on 21th of Sep and program committee will decide the program order.
- 3. Please make sure that your setup time is at most 2 minutes. So, if you have props, plan accordingly. We want to maximize the number of programs and minimize the gap between programs to keep the audience engaged. We request that each participant join only for one or two programs.
- 4. You will be allowed to use the green room only 20 minutes before the start time of your program. So please plan your costumes accordingly. Performers can assemble in the balcony or loading area prior to that. There is a limit to the number of people who can be at the green room at any given period that is governed by the fire code of the auditorium.
- 5. You will not be allowed to use Alta, markers, or nail polish at the venue. KAW reserves the right to cancel a program if any participant is found using them. Additionally, we will also require the team to pay for any fines we incur.
- 6. Sequences of any kind will not be allowed on costumes and props, as they damage the stage as well as the green rooms. KAW reserves the right to cancel a program if any participant is found using them. Additionally, we will also require the team to pay for any fines we incur.
- 7. Participants are requested to bring their own tapes for marking. The Theater will allow only "Spike Tape". You can find them online on PNTA.com.
- 8. Max expected duration for a program is 5 min. If your program requires more than 5 min, pls contact secretary@kaow.org
